What is a Hackathon?

A hackathon is a collaborative event where teams "hack" solutions to real-world problems and compete for prizes. This is a great event for high school students that promotes teamwork, innovation, skill building, and a sense of accomplishment in completing fun and meaningful projects. Ponderosa Hacks is a student organized event. We want to host a hackathon in Flagstaff since there are limited computer programming events and clubs in our local area. We hope you will help to support us!
